

Work Health & Safety

The management of O'Donnell & Hanlon is committed to ensuring that, as far as practicable, all work sites will be safe without risks to health.

Our principle objectives are to

- Provide a safe place of work for all workers of the company, those of our subcontractors and members of the public during the course of our activities
- Maintain compliance with applicable Health and Safety statutory requirements and legislation including approved codes of practice, standards and guidelines
- Cooperate with statutory and non-statutory bodies concerning health and safety
- Ensure that all workers of the company are aware of the importance of conformance with statutory requirements and company policy
- Establish measurable objectives and targets to ensure continued improvement aimed at elimination of work related injury and illness
- Maintain accreditation to the the Australian Government Building and Construction OHS Accreditation Scheme.

To achieve these objectives the company shall

- Implement and maintain an work health and safety management system comprising of policies and procedures which comply with the Federal Safety Commissioner Guidelines, WHS Act NSW 2011 and AS/NZS 4801
- Appoint a management representative who shall be responsible for ensuring the system is implemented and maintained across the company and report back to management on the company's performance
- Provide ongoing WHS training for all workers of the company
- Conduct ongoing inspections and a periodic program of audits to verify the effective implementation of the Work Health and Safety System
- Continually review the performance of the system to ensure its continuing suitability and effectiveness.

The cooperation of all workers and subcontractors on company sites is required as a contribution to health, safety and the implementation of this policy.
